# Operational Waste In Healthcare

The US Healthcare System wastes over **\$700B** annually.



## Operational Inefficiencies

Inefficiencies of resource utilization (facilities & people) and lack of coordination in care due to data and communication gaps.

### Long ED Wait Times

**~\$10-20B**

Inefficient bed allocation & turnover leading to ED crowding/boarding.



### Misrouted Patients

**~\$2-3B**

### Extended Length of Stay

**~\$45-65B**

Complex & inefficient discharge processes lead to additional patient days.



### Secondary Infections

**~\$5-10B**

### Inefficient Staff & Resource Utilization

**~\$10-20B**

Overutilization of costly resources in absence of streamlined workforce management and scheduling practices.
