Operational Inefficiencies


Inefficiencies of resource utilization (facilities & people) and lack of coordination in care due to data and communication gaps.



Long ED Wait Times

~\$10-20B

Inefficient bed allocation & turnover leading to ED crowding/boarding.





Misrouted Patients

~\$2-3B


Time wasted due to misrouting of patients to the wrong care site.



Extended Length of Stay

~\$45-65B

Complex & inefficient discharge processes lead to additional patient days.



Secondary Infections

~\$5-10B

Illnesses acquired due to avoidable, longer stays and/or inadequate hygiene monitoring in hospitals.



Poor Communication

~\$5-10B

Non-compatible data across disconnected information systems.



Inefficient Staff

& Resource Utilization

Overutilization of costly resources in absence of streamlined workforce management and scheduling practices.
